

Principal SRRV Applicants are required to **remit** the visa deposit based on the SRRV option being applied for. The visa deposit must be remitted from any bank abroad to any of the PRA-Accredited Banks.

Step 2: Request a Letter of Introduction (LOI) by sending the following details to clientrelations@pra.gov.ph

Step 3: After 2-3 working days, claim the LOI and present it to your chosen bank when opening the required Special Time Deposit Account for SRRV Application.

Step 4: Transfer the required visa deposit using the bank information and instructions provided by your bank.
